



## **Anne Look Education Scholarship Criteria**

***Four scholarships will be available annually. One recipient will be chosen from each of the following schools: Iron Mountain, Kingsford, North Dickinson, and Norway High Schools. The recipients shall receive a renewable scholarship award in an amount to be determined annually based upon the earned income of the fund.***

### **Criteria:**

1. The recipient must be a graduating Iron Mountain High School, Kingsford High School, North Dickinson School, or Norway High School senior.
2. The applicant may be enrolling in either a 2-year (Associate) or 4-year degree curriculum and pursuing a career in Early Childhood Education. If no applicants are pursuing a career in Early Childhood Education, then careers in General Education (teaching) will be considered.
3. The applicant must have a GPA of 2.75 GPA or higher.
4. A transcript of the student's high school records must be provided.
5. Applicants must submit one character reference letter from a teacher and one from a person who is familiar with the student (cannot be a family member).
6. The applicant must write a paragraph which includes their comments on their selected field of study and/or the Early Childhood Education or General Education (teaching) profession.
7. All applicants must adhere to Guidance Counselor deadlines. Failure to turn in a completed application by the due date will result in the student being ineligible for this scholarship. Guidance Counselors, all completed applications must be returned to DACF by March 15<sup>th</sup>.
8. Selection of the recipient(s) shall be based on financial need as well as academic performance and extracurricular activities at the discretion of the Scholarship Selection Advisory Committee.
9. The **Anne Look Education Scholarship** shall be a renewable award of four equal payments over a four-year period, providing the recipient remains eligible to receive the award. To remain eligible for the renewable award, the recipient must be a full-time student (12 or more credit hours per semester or the equivalent), maintain a minimum GPA of 2.75, and continue to major in Early Childhood or General Education. The recipient must submit their official college transcript to DACF each year to confirm eligibility prior to award disbursement.

10. A scholarship award may be revoked by the DACF Board of Trustees because of:

- Criminal or anti-social conduct of recipient,
- Filing false information on application,
- Failure to provide the Dickinson Area Community Foundation with documents and verification as specified in the Foundation's established policies for renewing scholarships,
- For such other good cause as the Board may, in its sole discretion, determine.

Revocation shall be by the action of a majority of the members of the DACF Board of Trustees, and upon such revocation, any and all funds still controlled by the Board of Trustees, shall be withheld and disposed of at the discretion of the Board.
