

## **Groveland Mine Solar Scholarship Criteria**

Established by Circle Power in 2023. One or more scholarship recipients will be chosen annually from both Norway High School and North Dickinson High School. The recipients will receive a one-time scholarship award.

#### Criteria:

- 1. The scholarship is available to graduating seniors of Norway High School and North Dickinson High School.
- 2. The scholarship is a single award and may not be renewed.
- 3. Applicants must have been:
  - a. Accepted at an accredited two- or four-year college or university and pursuing a STEM degree; or preparing for a career in the energy sector by pursuing a degree in STEM, public policy, or another applicable course of study.
  - b. Entering the "trades" field through an apprenticeship, certificate, or associate degree program; or
  - c. Entering a degree-granting program in the manufacturing/construction
- 4. A transcript of the student's high school records must be supplied.
- 5. Applicants must include an essay stating how they prepared themselves through high school for the field of study they are entering and how this field of study will fit into their future plans once they are finished with college.
- 6. Applicants must submit a letter from a teacher who has known the applicant for a minimum of one year. The reference letter must address the writer's perception of the student's capabilities and skills to succeed in their chosen field of study. In addition, the reference letter should address the writer's perception of the student's overall character.
- 7. The financial need of the applicant shall be a factor in the selection of students for the scholarship, but not the sole factor, as outstanding academic achievement and strength of character shall also be considered major factors in student selection.
- 8. All applicants must adhere to Guidance Counselor deadlines. Failure to turn in a completed application by the due date will result in the student being ineligible for this scholarship. Guidance Counselors, all completed applications must be returned to DACF by March 15<sup>th</sup>.
