



The Gust K. Newberg Construction Company Scholarship Criteria

***Available to seniors attending high schools of Dickinson County, Michigan
Iron Mountain, Kingsford, Norway/Vulcan, North Dickinson***

***The Gust K. Newberg Construction company Scholarship has been
established for the purpose of perpetuating interest in the fields of
Engineering, Architecture and related professions of construction.***

***At least one scholarship each year will be awarded to a worthy graduate of
each of the following school districts: the Iron Mountain School District,
the Breitung Township School District, the Norway/Vulcan School District
and the North Dickinson County School District.***

***The Gust K. Newberg Construction Company Scholarship does not engage
in discrimination with respect to an applicant's age, sex, color, national
origin, or religion.***

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Applicants must have maintained a minimum of a C (2.0) grade point average through seven semesters of high school to be considered for the scholarship.
2. Applicants must commence his or her academic career at their respective high school not later than the beginning of the fall semester of their junior year.
3. Applicants must be accepted for admission to an accredited four-year college or university.
4. Applicants shall have taken the ACT or SAT prior to the deadline for submitting their application.
5. Applicants must adhere to Guidance Counselor deadlines. Failure to turn in a completed application by the due date will result in the student being ineligible for this scholarship. Guidance Counselors, all completed applications must be returned to DACF by March 15th.
6. The scholarship will be terminated if the recipient changes his/her course of study to any course other than a construction-related field.

Application Requirements

The following documents are necessary for consideration of the Gust K. Newberg Construction Company Scholarship.

1. The regular application form with all questions answered.
2. A copy of the applicant's high school transcript through the seventh (7th) semester.
3. Scores from the ACT or SAT.
4. One letter of recommendation from a teacher of the student's choice to be delivered directly to the Scholarship Administrator not later than March 15. This letter should not be made available to the applicant.
5. A personal statement on any matter the applicant wishes to call to the attention of the Advisory Committee.
6. The applicant must state what field of Engineering or Architecture he/she will pursue, and how it applies to the construction industry.

Criteria for Selection

1. A selection committee from each named school district will recommend a candidate to the Newberg Advisory Committee.
2. The Newberg Advisory Committee will thoroughly review the applications of each candidate based on the information requested.
3. The Newberg Advisory Committee will consider candidates on the basis of scholastic performance in high school, potential to succeed based on the ACT or SAT scores, and overall personality in relationship to effort, attitude and citizenship shown by his/her school record.
4. The Newberg Advisory Committee will make the final scholarship award recommendations to the DACF Board.

Renewal Criteria

The **Gust K. Newberg Construction Company Scholarship** may be renewed for up to eight semesters provided the student maintains a minimum 2.0 GPA, remains a full-time student (12 credit hours per semester) in a four-year college or university, and remains in an engineering/ construction-related field of study. Procedures for submitting verification of continued eligibility are outlined in the Dickinson Area Community Foundation Scholarship Renewal Policy.

Disbursement Procedures

Disbursement of scholarship awards will be in accordance with the Dickinson Area Community Foundation Scholarship Renewal Policy.

Scholarship Revocation

A scholarship award may be revoked by the DACF Board of Trustees because of:

- Criminal or anti-social conduct of recipient.
- Filing false information on application.
- Scholastic inadequacy of a recipient.
- Failure to provide the Dickinson Area Community Foundation with documents and verification as specified in the Foundation's established policies for renewing scholarships.
- For such other good cause as the Board may, in its sole discretion, determine.

Revocation shall be by the action of a majority of the members of the DACF Board of Trustees, and upon such revocation, any and all funds still controlled by the Board of Trustees shall be withheld and disposed of at the discretion of the Board.
